



# Shrubs - Pg 1



## Arborvitae - Goldy

An upright, broadly conical selection of western arborvitae with bold plates of rich, creamy yellow foliage with orange overtones. The color is very durable throughout the seasons, only becoming more orange in winter. Easy to grow. 6' tall with a 4' spread. Full sun to part shade and well drained soil.

# Shrubs - Pg 2



## Boxwood

A versatile landscape shrub that works well as a specimen, hedge, or mass planting. Great choice for hedges. Evergreen and deer resistant. Slow growing, 15-20' high and spread at maturity.



## Cotoneaster - Dwarf Winged

Low-growing – 1-2' tall, 3-6' spreading deciduous shrub. This cultivar is the dwarf version of the species and will grow smaller and more dense. White-pink flowers appear in early-summer turning to small bright red berries. Small rounded leaves turn purple to red in the fall. Requires very little pruning. Drought tolerant.

## Purple Lilac White Lilac



A tough, reliable and fragrant shrub. Can live for more than 100 years. Grows 8-12' tall. Full sun, well drained soil. Attracts pollinators.

# Shrubs - Pg 4



## Mock Orange - *Philadelphus*

A native shrub grown for its fragrant spring flowers. Used as specimen plants and in groupings for borders and screens. They provide spring interest when they produce a profusion of fragrant flowers that smell like orange blossoms. 2-10' high and spread. Full sun to part shade and moist but well drained soils.



## Oregon Grape - *Mahonia repens*

An evergreen groundcover that is adaptable to full sun or shade. It likes well-drained soil, but will adapt. In the spring, bright yellow flowers glow against the shiny dark holly-like leaves, followed by purple-blue berries. It is drought resistant once established. It is deer resistant and attracts bees. Birds like the berries. Grows to 12'.

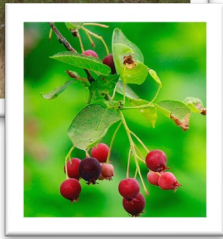


# Shrubs - Pg 6



## Serviceberry – *Amelanchier arborea*

Large native shrubs or single- or multi-stemmed small trees. Great as a key plant in or as a group plantings in borders, backdrops and screens. Provides year-round interest in white spring flowers, yellow to red fall foliage, smooth gray bark. 15-30' high and spread. Full sun to part shade, moist but well drained soil.



## Spirea

Flowering shrubs with delicate lacy flowers that come in white, pink, red or mauve. Finely toothed foliage comes in shades of green, chartreuse, gold, blue. Drought tolerant once established. Attracts pollinators.

## Viburnum Lantana



A deciduous shrub with stout spreading branches and naked buds. Small cream colored flowers in clusters mature to black berries.

- Grows 10' to 15' tall.
- Sun to part shade.
- Tolerates poor soils.
- Hardy to zone 4.
