Yarrow Summer Berries – *Achillea millefolium*

Clusters of flat-headed flowers on upright stems with aromatic, finely cut, fern-like leaves. Profuse bloomers. Mix of intense red, cerise, and pink flower shades. Light watering, well-draining soil. Drought tolerant once established. Height: 24”- 36” Consider staking. Attracts bees, butterflies, hummingbirds. Fast and easy growing, good for containers. **WARNING: Poisonous if ingested. Skin and eye irritant. Toxic to dogs, cats, and horses.**

Arcado Pink Hyssop – *Agastache 'Arcado Pink'*

Dazzles with its tall spikes of soft, pink blossoms that sway gracefully against aromatic, minty foliage, drawing in bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds to its nectar-rich blooms. Sustains beneficial insects. Full sun, hardy, heat, drought tolerant. Moderate water with free-draining soil, but can tolerate almost any soil type. Deer and rabbit resistant.



Agastache Arizona Series – *Agastache aurantiaca*

Cold hardy perennial. Fragrant, exotic looking bright orange flowers with coral hues, blooms summer to fall. Attracts butterflies, hummingbirds, bees. Deer/rabbit resistant. Moderate water, sandy & loamy soils with good drainage, heat and drought tolerant when established, full sun. Mature Height and Width: 2-3' tall, 1 - 2' wide.





Queeny Purple Hollyhock - *Alcea rosea*

Frlly-edged, purple double flowers resembling powder puffs. Blooms from the bottom up. Continuous blooms from mid to late summer. Full sun, average water with well-draining soil. Mature height 2 – 3', width 10 – 12". Shorter stature. Deer and rabbit resistant, attracts butterflies, birds, and bees. 2004 AAS Flower Winner.

Basket of Gold - *Alyssum 'Montanum Luna'*

Dazzles with arching stems that cascade like streams of gold, crowned by clusters of vibrant yellow flowers. Together, they create a cheerful, glowing carpet that enlivens any garden. Full sun, well-drained, rocky, or sandy soils. Heat, drought-tolerant when established. Bees and butterflies drawn to nectar rich blooms. Deer, rabbit resistant.



Columbine Earlybird Mix - *Aquilegia 'Earlybird Mix'*

Prized for vibrant colors, neatly mounded habit. Blooms profusely late spring to early summer. Blossoms on short stems and rise elegantly above the lacy, deeply-cut foliage. Mature height & width: 9-12". Full sun to partial shade. Moderate watering and can tolerate average, rich and well-drained soils. Magnet for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Columbine Tequila Sunrise – *Aquilegia, skinnerii*

Fiery orange-red petals and golden-yellow centers reminiscent of a glowing sunrise. Its delicate, nodding blooms appear in late spring to early summer. Height of 24–40". Full sun to partial shade. Moderate watering and can tolerate average, rich and well-drained soils. Magnet for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Armeria (Thrift) -*Armeria pseudarmeria Ballerina Series*

Refined charm enchants with its slender, breezy stems and vibrant pom-pom blooms, elegantly contrasting its lush, grassy base. Flowers are lilac, pink, red, or white. Full sun to part shade. Fast growing. Dead head to encourage reblooming. Adored by bees and butterflies. Deer/rabbit resistant. Compact perennial typically reaches 12" height. Drought tolerant once established.



Butterfly Weed – *Asclepias tuberosa*

Upright, slightly fuzzy stems supporting clusters of brilliant orange, red, or yellow flowers. Star-shaped blooms burst forth in midsummer, creating a dazzling beacon for pollinators. Full sun, prefers dry, well-drained soil, sandy or rocky conditions. Once established, drought-tolerant. Magnet for bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Rabbit, deer resistant. North American native, low-maintenance, striking addition to any pollinator-friendly landscape.

Borage Starflower – *Borago officinalis*

A celestial wonder, with sturdy, branching stems clothed in soft, silvery hairs giving them a dreamy, ethereal appearance. Above textured greenery, dazzling blue, star-shaped blooms unfurl, their delicate petals surrounding deep purple stamens. Full sun, moderate watering with well-drained, fertile soil, drought resistant when established. Attracts bees, butterflies. Deer, rabbit resistant. This resilient herb not only adds charm but also offers medicinal and culinary benefits.

Butterfly Bush – *Buddleia davidii*

Long, arching stems crowned by dense clusters of fragrant, cone-shaped blooms in shades of purple, pink, or white. Nectar-rich flowers attract butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds. Full sun to partial shade, well-drained soil, drought-tolerant once established, Deer and rabbit resistant. Continuous summer-to-fall blooms.



Figaro Mix Dahlia - *Dahlia x hybrida*

Blooming season: spring through fall. Brilliantly colored double blooms in shades of yellow, orange, violet, red and white. An annual, but tubers can be dug up and replanted the following spring. Full to part sun, medium water with well-draining loamy soil. Attracts bees. Susceptible to slugs, snails, rabbits, earwigs and aphids. 14-18" height and 10-12" spread.

Carpatian Bellflower 'Blue' – *Campanula carpatica* 'Blue'

This miniature to small perennial blooms early spring through late summer with vibrant violet blue, cup-shaped flowers that will rebloom if deadheaded. This easy-to-grow plant does well as a border or edging plant, in a container or a color block planting, which is attractive to bees. Part to full sun. 5-7" tall with 5-8" spread.

Carpatian Bellflower 'White Clips'

Campanula carpatica 'White Clips'

Low-growing perennial with white upturned, bell-shaped flowers that nearly cover the plant. Can self-sow but not invasive. Blooms early summer through early fall. Works well as a ground cover, underplanting for shrubs or roses and in containers. Part to full sun. 6-12" tall with 8-12" spread.



Jupiter's Beard - *Centranthus ruber* 'Pretty Betsy'

Delightful perennial with sturdy, upright stems crowned by clusters of fragrant, starry blooms in rich shades of pink, red. Blooms late spring to early autumn. Deadhead to prevent dandelion-like seeds disbursement. Attracts bees, butterflies. Part to full sun, well-drained, moderately fertile soil with low to moderate watering, drought tolerant once established. 24-36" tall, 18-24" wide.

Clematis

Clematis prefer moist and well-drained soil and like their “heads in the sun and feet in the shade.” Attracts bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds.

Warning: Toxic to dogs, cats, and horses.



Avant Garde - Hardy, showy profusion of semi-double, deep pinkish-red flowers 2” across, adorned with central pom-pom of pale pink petals. Profusion of flowers from mid-summer to early fall. Small flowered ‘summer’ Clematis group called Viticella. 9-10’ tall. Group 3 pruning in late winter or early spring. Rabbit and deer resistant.

Princess Diana - Showy, small, tulip shaped, deep pink flowers with paler pink margins and medium green foliage. Flowers about 2.5” long. Profuse blooms June – Sept. Flowers are followed by silky seed heads. Thrives in full sun to partial shade, prefers moist, well-drained soil. 6-8’ tall. Deer and rabbit resistant. Group 3 pruning in late winter or early spring.



Radar Love - Vigorous climber with twining stems and vibrant, bell-shaped yellow flowers (2 – 4”) that nod gracefully in summer, followed by silky seedheads for added appeal. Height of 8 feet, ultimate height of 13’ or more over several years. Width ranges 1.6–3.3 feet. Thrives in full sun to partial shade, prefers moist, well-drained soil. Hardy in zones 4–9. Deer, rabbit resistant. Group 3-Hard pruning recommended in early spring. Good choice for beginners, easy to grow.



Tickseed - *Coreopsis grandiflora* 'Double the Sun'

Large-Flowered Tickseed, radiant perennial with semi-double, golden-yellow blooms that dazzle from late spring through summer. Sturdy, upright stems 12–14 inches. Full sun, prefers well-draining soil, drought-tolerant once established. Able to self-seed. Perennial is hardy to -30°F. Blooms earlier than most coreopsis. Attracts bees and butterflies. Deer, rabbit resistant.

Tickseed - *Coreopsis grandiflora* 'Early Sunrise'

Cheerful, upright stems that support semi-double, golden-yellow blooms kissed with orange hues at their centers. Early bloomer thrives in full sun, well-drained soil with dry to medium moisture, making it a low-maintenance choice for sunny gardens. 18" tall, carefree, provides a wealth of cut flowers, remove spent blooms to maintain profuse blooming. Attracts bees, butterflies. Rabbit and deer resistant.



Tickseed 'Heliot' - *Coreopsis grandiflora* 'Heliot'

Vibrant golden-yellow daisies accented by burgundy rings around the center disk. Its sturdy, leafless stems rise gracefully, supporting blooms that last from early summer to autumn. Full sun, prefers well-draining soil, prefers dry to moist conditions. Attracts bees and butterflies. Deer, rabbit resistant. Hardy in zones 4–9, it's a dazzling addition to any garden.

Delphinium Bellamosum - *Delphinium x belladonna*

Scattered florets arranged like stars of midnight-blue along their flower spikes adding grace and stature to your garden! Bloom early summer and often again after first flush. Outstanding cut flower. Full sun, protect from wind, moist fertile soil. Attracts hummingbirds, bees, and butterflies. Deer resistant.

WARNING: Toxic to children and pets.

Delphinium 'Blue Mirror'-*Delphinium grandiflorum 'Blue Mirror'*

Tall spires of brilliant violet-blue flowers rises above a tuft of large, deeply cut foliage. Staking not required. Outstanding cut flower. Blooms through late summer. Prefers full sun protected from high winds. 12 – 18” tall, 18” wide. Soil consistently moist, but not soggy. Enjoys compost enriched soils. Add balanced, slow-release fertilizer. Attracts hummingbirds, bees, butterflies. Deer resistant. **WARNING: Toxic to children and pets.**



Delphinium 'Summer Series' Larkspur -

Delphinium grandiflorum 'Summer Series'

Compact perennial with bushy, well-branched stems that support loose sprays of single, spurred flowers in vibrant shades of blue, pink, or white. Delicate blooms create an enchanting display that adds elegance to borders, containers, or cottage gardens. Prefers full sun protected from high winds. 10 – 12” tall & wide. Prefers fertile, medium moisture, well-drained soil. Attracts hummingbirds, bees, butterflies. Deer & rabbit resistant.

WARNING: Toxic to children and pets.





Coneflower – *Echinacea x hybrida* ‘Artisan Yellow Ombre’

Compact with sturdy, upright stems that support large, single blooms. Flowers open in intense golden-yellow hues, gradually soften as they age, creating a stunning ombre effect. Deadhead for continue blooming until late fall. Full sun, light moisture. Somewhat drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant. 24-34” tall, 10-25” wide. Winner of the 2023 All-America Selections (AAS) Perennial Award for its uniform growth habit, vibrant flowers, and prolific blooming.

Coneflower – *Echinacea purpurea* ‘Bravado’

Its towering stems and striking rose-pink petals form a halo around a fiery orange cone. Its vibrant beauty and alluring fragrance make it a charming focal point in any garden. Deadhead for continued blooming until late fall. Full sun, thrives in average, dry to medium moisture with well-drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. 3 – 4’ tall, 1.5-2’ wide. Deer resistant.



Coneflower – *Echinacea* ‘Cheyenne Spirit’

Kaleidoscope of sunset hues—purple, pink, red, orange, yellow, cream, and white. Large, daisy-like blossoms, 3-4 inches wide, are perched on sturdy, well-branched stems that remain upright even in wind and rain. Deadhead for continue blooming until late fall. Full sun, thrives in average, dry to medium moisture with well-drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. 24-30” tall, 12-24” wide. Winner of the 2013 All-America Selections Award and Europe’s FleuroSelect Gold Medal for garden performance.

Coneflower PowWow Wild Berry- *Echinacea purpurea* 'PAS702917'

Dazzling, bursting with deep rose-purple blooms, that retain their rich color as they mature. Each flower, up to 3-4 inches wide, sits atop sturdy, well-branched stems that require no staking. Deadhead for continue blooming until late fall. Full sun, thrives in average, dry to medium moisture with well-drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant. 18-24" tall, 12-16" wide. Winner of the 2010 All-America Selections Gold Medal Award.

Coneflower – *Echinacea purpurea* *'Primadonna Deep Rose'*

Dazzling garden gem, flaunts deep rose-hued, daisy-like blooms with gracefully drooping petals frame a bold orange-brown cone. Its sturdy, well-branched stems stand tall, unfazed by wind or weather. 2 – 3' tall, 1.5-2' wide. Deadhead for continued blooming until late fall. Full sun, thrives in average, dry to medium moisture with well-drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. Deer resistant.



Coneflower – *Echinacea purpurea* 'White Swan'

Large, daisy-like blooms featuring pure white petals that reflex away from a coppery-orange, spiky central cone. These honey-scented flowers sit atop sturdy, upright stems, creating an elegant and serene display. 2-3' tall, 1-2' wide. Deadhead for continued blooming until late fall. Full sun, thrives in average, dry to medium moisture with well-drained soils. Drought tolerant once established. Winner of the 2009 Great Plant Picks Award.



Blanket Flower 'Arizona Apricot' -

Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Arizona Apricot'

Cheerful, compact perennial that dazzles with soft apricot-orange blooms accented by golden-yellow tips. 12" tall and wide. Full sun, average moisture, well-drained soils. Deadhead to encourage further blooms from early summer to fall. Attracts butterflies and bees. Deer resistant. Winner of the 2011 All-America Selections Award.

Blanket Flower 'Arizona Red' -

Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Arizona Red Shades'

Fiery burst of color, with large crimson-red blooms with yellow tips. Divide every 2 - 3 years in spring or early fall. 10-12" tall and wide. Excellent cut flowers. Full sun, average moisture, well-drained soils. Attracts bees and butterflies. Deer resistant. Drought and heat tolerant once established.



Blanket Flower 'Mesa Custom Mix' -

Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Mesa Custom Mix'

Vibrant tapestry of color, showcasing red, peach, yellow, and bi-colored blooms that brighten gardens all season long. 14-16" tall and 20-22" wide. Full sun, average moisture, well-drained soils. Deadhead to encourage further blooms from summer to fall. Attracts butterflies and bees. Deer resistant.

Butterfly Gaura - *Gaura lindheimeri* 'Sparkle White'

Forms a mound of narrow, green leaves with airy, arching stems of dainty white flowers tinged pink from late spring through late summer. They move constantly in a breeze and look like a cloud of small butterflies. Must have excellent drainage, prefers sandy or loamy well-drained soil. Heat and drought tolerant once established. Attracts hummingbirds. Deer resistant.

Iceland Poppy - *Papaver nudicalue* 'Champagne Bubbles Scarlet'

Large, fragrant, brilliant orange blossoms with crinkled petals and golden stamens. Excellent cut flowers. Plant forms small, basal rosette of blue-green, pinnately lobed leaves. 8-12" tall and wide. Deadheading encourages more buds to form. Do not disturb crown in late winter when not readily seen. Full sun, moderate moisture, well-drained soil. Attracts bees. Deer and rabbit resistant.



Orient Poppy - *Papaver nudicalue* 'Orient Allegro'

Large, solitary, crepe papery 4-6" flowers with 4-6 orange-red petals with dark basal blotches with dark purple center stamens. Foliage: Serrate, thistle-like, grayish-green leaves (up to 12 inches long) that are pinnately dissected into lance-shaped segments. 12-18" tall, 8-12" spread. Full sun, average moisture, well-drained soil. Do not disturb the crown in late winter when not readily seen. Attracts bees. Deer and rabbit resistant.

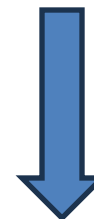
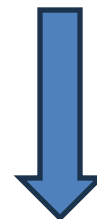
